

Doug Wefer, 17-year-old Port Washington, N.Y. sailor copped both the Junior and Senior North American Penguin Class Championships.

Wefer, an incoming freshman at the University of Michigan and a prospective business administration major, had as his crew his sister Ellen, 15. He is the third sailor to win both Junior and Senior titles in a single season: Larry Leonard of Annapolis, Md., did it a decade ago, and Shawn Kempton, Ocean Gate Y.C., accomplished it three years ago when it was sailed at Toms River.

The Port Washington Skipper won the Junior Championship with five firsts, and in the Senior event he won three of the six races and never finished worse than fourth in the one-throwout series. Doug and Ellen demonstrated excellent teamwork throughout the four days of racing. "We consider ourselves equal in the boat," Wefer commented. "I think one reason we do well is because we get along and communicate well. While racing, she watches the compass and I steer and watch the water ahead. Working together makes things easier."

In the senior event, they were up against such formidable foes as Neal Fowler, Terry Kempton, and Ron Leuvelink, all former champions of the 11¹/₂-foot dinghy. However, the Wefer duo had the boat speed necessary to clinch things.

The junior races were sailed Monday and Tuesday through light and slightly shifting 6-8 mile easterlies, and triangular and modified Gold Cup courses about 5 miles in length.

Three races opened the Senior Championship on Wednesday. After an uneventful first race, a squall blew in during the second, and the third race was sailed in steady rain and heavy winds. Eight protests developed during these two days.

Hans Wagner, 14, of Mantoloking Y.C., a sophomore at Wall High School, finished in second place in the juniors with a 6-2-4-2-5 record. His crew was clubmate Peter VanDuyne, 15. Doug Olsen, Richmond County Y.C., Staten Island, N.Y. was third over-all in the 10-boat fleet. Glen Zimmerman, Metedeconk River Y.C., was fourth.

In the senior event, Neal Fowler with Kathy Contildes, Seawanhaka Corinthian Y.C., was second while Terry Kempton, with crew Ann Edelblut, was third. Ron and Mibi Leuvelink, Potomac River Y.C., Washington, D.C. took fourth, while Phil Reynolds, Island Heights, Y.C., was fifth in the 28-boat fleet.
